A cavy can be shown in both purebred and pet class and as a part of a breeding group if wanted.

Arrival and checking in:

Friday: 17-20

Saturday: 8-9.45

If you need to check in outside of these check in times, please ask if it's possible.

All cavies MUST be checked in by SMY personnel in charge of animal inspections. All animals need to be free of all lice (including static), ringworm or any contagious diseases. Bleeding wounds, flaky patches on the skin or legs, pregnancy diarrhoea, fungus and generally bad condition are examples when the animal is going to be disqualified. If two of the animal personnel in charge of inspection both agree about disqualification, cavies are going to be transferred to a separate guarantee space. The owner can't complain about the decision.

Judging starts on Saturday and Sunday at 10 and all efforts are made to end the show on Sunday by 15.00.

There is a possibility that this show is cageless but we are going to inform more about the matter in our later update. We are still working on that.

Shavings, water, hay and some vegetables will be available at the show venue. You MUST take care according to animal welfare laws that animals have access to food and fresh water all times during their stay at the show venue. It's possible to leave cavies at the show venue overnight.

All cavies must be present both days during the show. The exceptions are junior classes which are judged on Saturday.

The Dinner will be held at Hotel Korpilampi. SMY has booked some rooms for the show participants and the hotel allows pets. More information about the dinner coming soon.

Accommodation:

You can stay at the same hotel (Hotelli Korpilampi) where the dinner is. SMY has booked 10 single rooms and 10 double rooms. In case you would like to stay there, send a questionnaire to 2024nordic@gmail.com. Of course you are able to book also from their website.
